

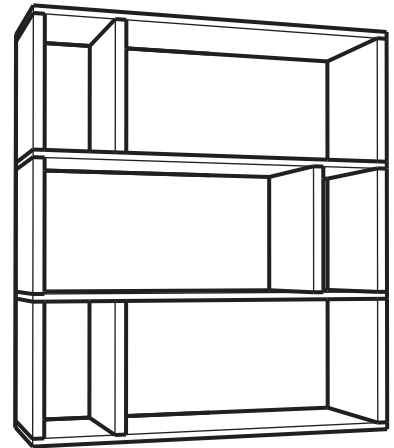
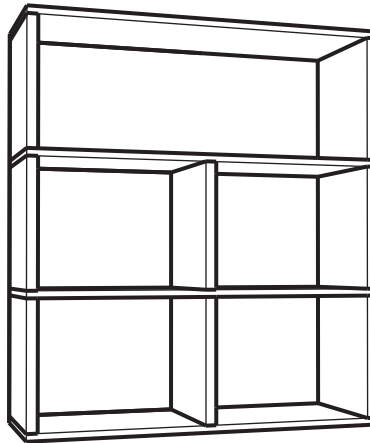
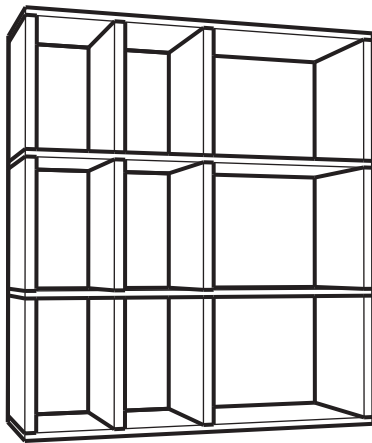
This guide shows how to use zBoard divider/support boards. There are infinite configurations and designs possible. Below you will find only a few possibilities. Remember to share your designs with us and get them posted in the Way Basics Design Gallery!

TIP: Add divider boards starting from the bottom shelf (if your furniture has more than 1 shelf).

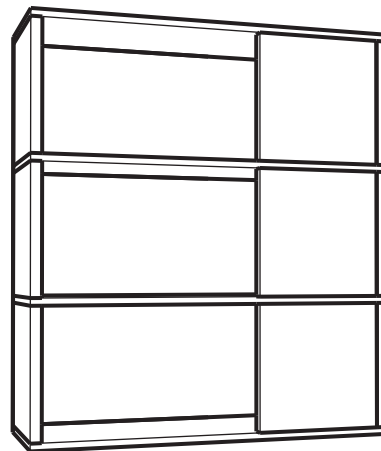
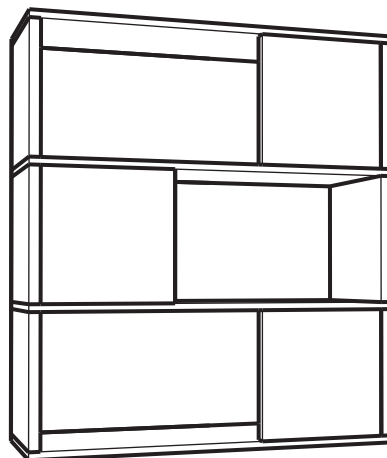
TIP: Multiple divider/support boards are possible in a shelf.

TIP: Mix and match the way you position your zBoard. Get creative and position your zBoard parallel to the sides or perpendicular for a door style look.

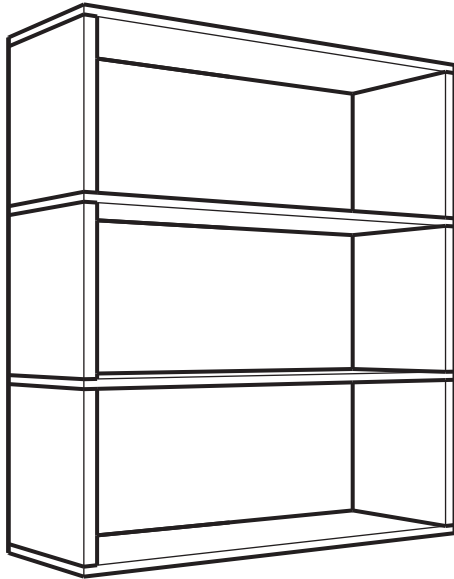
TIP: Your zBoards can simply slide into place without removing the adhesive tape. If you would like to secure them into place, follow the guide on the next page



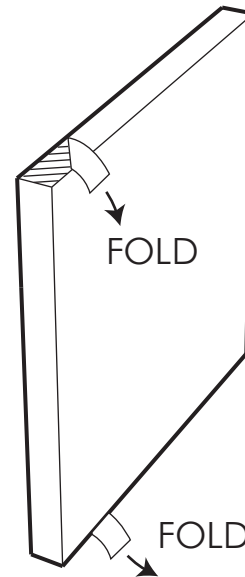
parallel configuration possibilities



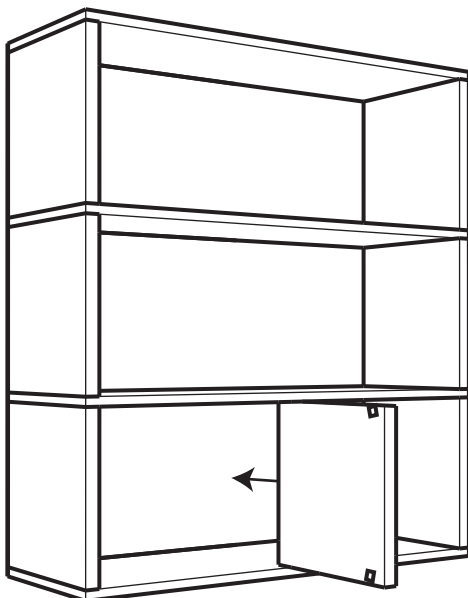
perpendicular configuration possibilities



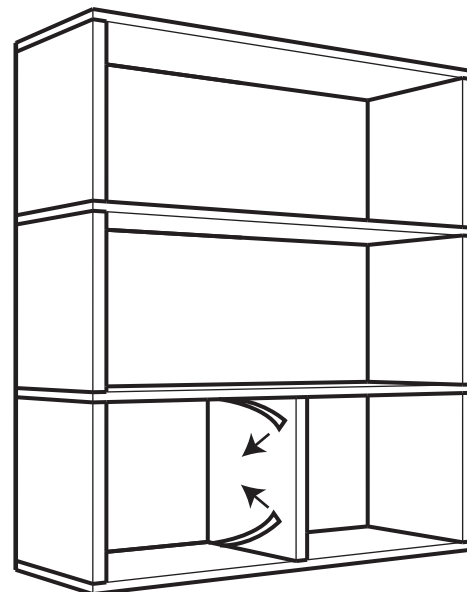
1. Start with an assembled unit.



2. Fold about 1 inch of the protective layer back on the top and bottom edges of your divider to form tabs. This step is optional, but is recommended for best results.



3. Slide the divider into the desired location with the tape edges at the top and bottom, and with tabs toward the front.



4. Gently pull the tabs to remove the protective layers and expose the tape. Firmly place pressure on top of the zBoard to stick the adhesive securely.
